

PARENTS' CODE OF ETHICS 2022

- 1. I hereby pledge to provide support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents' Code of Ethics Pledge.**
- 2. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and park staff at every game, practice or other youth sporting event.**
- 3. I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.**
- 4. I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.**
- 5. I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.**
- 6. I will remember the game is for my child and the other children and not for the adults.**
- 7. I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.**
- 8. I will ask my child and expect that my child will treat other players, coaches, fans, officials and park staff with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.**
- 9. I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assist with coaching, assist the league in whatever way possible.**
- 10. I will have my child at all scheduled practices and games. I will contact my coach if my child is not at a scheduled team event. I understand that flag football is a team sport and every player is needed by his/her teammates at all practices and games.**
- 11. I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that my child's coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Ethics.**
- 12. I understand that my child may be removed from a team and the league if my actions as a parent/spectator are in anyway inappropriate.**
- 13. I am aware that a Lightning Prediction System monitors the City of Plantation parks. I will insist that my child's coach immediately evacuate the fields and seek shelter in a nearby building or vehicle if the alarm sounds. I understand that one (1) long 15-second blast indicates immediate evacuation of all fields and that three (3) short 5-second blasts indicate all field activities may resume.**

I HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THE 2022 PAL FLAG FOOTBALL RULES AS STATED ON THE PAL WEBSITE.

If a coach or parent does not have access to a computer, a printed copy of the rules may be obtained by contacting their League Director. Ignorance shall not be accepted as an excuse for any violation of the rules.
